The story, despite the multiple readings it offers, is inseparable from the Black Lives Matter movement.

The picturebook also offers in the middle of the story 1 fold-out triptych that breaks the format of the classic diptych. It is just at the moment when the protagonist leaves the railway track, to make more evident the fact of breaking with the established schemes.
